NOTICE UNDER ARTICLE 14(2) OF THE ELECTRICITY (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1992

MODIFICATION OF POWER NI ELECTRICITY SUPPLY LICENCE

In pursuance of its powers under Article 14(1) of the Electricity (Northern Ireland) Order 1992 (as amended) (the “**Order**”), the Northern Ireland Authority for Utility Regulation (the “**Authority**”) hereby gives notice under Article 14(2) as follows:

- 1) We propose to amend Annex 3 of the Power NI licence. This Annex provides for the determination of the Power NI Energy Ltd Power Procurement Business (‘PPB’) regulated revenue amount.
- 2) The effect of these proposed modifications is to provide the mechanism to implement the Utility Regulator’s Final Determination on the PPB amount for 2015 to 2017 which was published on 1st July 2015.
- 3) The proposed modifications to the Power NI PPB electricity supply licence are set out in the Annex to this Notice.
