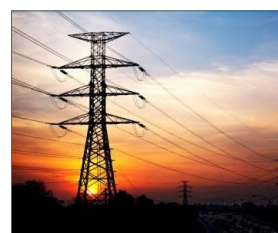


Notice of Proposed Modification to the Gas Supply Licence held by Go Power

7 January 2016

NOTICE UNDER ARTICLE 14(2) OF THE GAS (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1996

In pursuance of its powers under Article 14(1) of the Gas (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 (as amended) (the “**Order**”) and having obtained the consent of the Licensee, the Northern Ireland Authority for Utility Regulation (hereafter referred to as the “**Authority**”) hereby gives notice under Article 14(2) as follows:

- 1 The Authority proposes to modify the gas supply [licence](#) (the “**Licence**”) held by Go Power (the “**Licensee**”), a company established in Northern Ireland and having its principal place of business at 16 Churchtown Road, Cookstown, Co Tyrone, BT80 9XD.
- 2 The proposed modification is to amend the financial year in condition 1.2 of the licence. The financial year in the licence currently runs from 1 January to 31 December each year. The proposed modification will change the financial year to run from 1 October to the following 30 September.
- 3 The reason for the proposed modifications is to align the financial year in the licence to Go Power’s own statutory financial year. The modification is being proposed following a written request from the licensee.
- 4 The Authority considers that the proposed modification of the licence would be an appropriate course of action in order to align the financial year with the licensee’s own statutory reporting period of 1 October to 30 September.
- 5 The Authority considers that the proposed modification will not have any effect on any other energy supplier or on the Northern Ireland retail energy market.
- 6 The proposed modification is set out below.

In Condition 1.2 of the licence, existing paragraph 1.2.1 shall be substituted as follows:

“1.2.1 Financial years

For the purposes of this Condition the first financial year of the Licensee shall run from the date of the Grant to 31st December 2014. Thereafter each financial year of the Licensee shall run from 1st October to the following 30th September.”

- 7 The purpose of this notice is to bring the proposed modification to the attention of persons likely to be affected by it, and to invite representations or objections in connection thereto. In line with Article 14(3) of the Order, any representations

or objections with respect to the proposed modification may be made on or before 5TH February 2016 to:
