Development secondment to ESB Networks

I write in response to your letter dated 25 March 2019 regarding a potential development secondment of an individual from NIE Networks to ESB Networks. The letter seeks consent from the UR under Condition 12(3)(d)(iv) of your Licences to allow access for ESB Networks to the services of the secondee identified for a 18 month period.

The Condition 12(3)(d)(iv) states that:

3 The Licensee shall ensure that:

(d) any Associated Business does not use or have access to:

(iv) the services of persons who are (whether or not as their principal occupation) engaged in the management or operation of the [Transmission Ower Business/Distribution Business] (save to the extent the Authority consents to such use or access);

Direction

Haven reviewed the circumstances of this particular case, we can confirm consent under Licence Condition 12(3)(d)(iv) to enable ESB Networks access to the services of the secondee for the period of 18 months, beginning in Q3 2019 and ending in December 2020.

This Direction relates specifically to the secondee identified in your letter of 25 March 2019. The Utility Regulator continues to expect to be given sufficient advance notice to allow suitable time for consideration for any future movements of staff that may have an impact on compliance with relevant licence conditions.

This Direction will last to the 31 December 2020 and will be placed on the Public Electricity Register as required by the Electricity (NI) Order 1992.
