NOTICE UNDER ARTICLE 14(2) OF THE ELECTRICITY (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1992

MODIFICATION OF POWER NI ELECTRICITY SUPPLY LICENCE

In pursuance of its powers under Article 14(1) of the Electricity (Northern Ireland) Order 1992 (as amended) (the “**Order**”), the Northern Ireland Authority for Utility Regulation (the “**Authority**”) hereby gives notice under Article 14(2) as follows:

- 1) We propose to remove Annex 1 of the Power NI licence. This Annex refers to the ‘Non Fossil Fuel Obligation’ (“NFFO”) and it will be removed from the licence as the NFFO contracts have now expired. This Annex is, therefore, no longer relevant to the licensee. The UR will, therefore, mark the Annex as ‘not used’ in the licence.
- 2) In addition, condition 54 of the Power NI licence refers to Annex 1 and it will also, therefore, be marked as ‘not used’.
- 3) The effect of these proposals is to mark as unused those provisions noted above as they are no longer necessary.
- 4) The proposed modifications to the Power NI electricity supply licence are set out in Appendix 1 to this of the UR’s decision paper entitled “Changes to Gas and Electricity Licences with regards to Appeals to the CMA” published today with this notice.
